Job description

The Département de psychologie is seeking applications for a full-time tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor in research and intervention in the general domain of mental disorders leading to illegal behavior such as general delinquency, sexual delinquency, interpersonal violence, juvenile pornography and related problems such as psychopathy, substance addiction, impulsivity.

Responsibilities

The appointed candidate will be expected to teach at the undergraduate and at the graduate levels, supervise graduate students, engage in ongoing research and publication, and contribute to the academic life and reputation of the University. Teaching may take place at the Montreal campus or at the Laval campus.

Requirements

- Ph. D. (Research and Intervention) in Clinical Psychology.
- Ability to teach courses related to the evaluation and treatment of delinquency, risk assessment, paraphilia and related psychological problems.
- Relevant clinical experience with a delinquent population.
- Ability to develop and pursue a funded research program.
- Demonstrated ability, via publications, to make a contribution to the field and to contribute to academic and professional outreach of the Department. This position requires regular publications.
- Constitute assets :
 - o University teaching experience
 - o Experience in community or penal environments
 - o Ability to supervise clinical practica
- Member of, or eligibility to become member of the Ordre des psychologues du Québec.
- Proficiency in the French language*
