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### Job description

The Département de psychologie is seeking applications for a full-time tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor in Clinical Neuropsychology (Intervention).

### Responsibilities

The appointed candidate will be expected to teach mainly in the D. Psy. program in clinical neuropsychology, supervise graduate students' work leading to the production of theses or doctoral essays, engage in ongoing professional and/or academic research and publication, and contribute to the academic life and reputation of the University. Teaching may take place at the Montreal campus or at the Laval campus.

### Requirements

- Doctorate in Psychology (Ph.D. Research/Intervention or D. Psy.) or equivalent, with a specialization in clinical neuropsychology.
- Minimum of two years of relevant postdoctoral clinical experience (gained after doctorate) involving intervention with people presenting neuropsychological problems.
- Ability to supervise clinical practica in neuropsychological intervention.
- Demonstrated ability, via publications, to make an academic and professional contribution to the field. This position requires regular high-level publications in professional and academic journals.
- Interest in the development of the D. Psy. program in clinical neuropsychology.
- Constitute an asset:
  - Knowledge of the cognitive-behavioral approach
  - Ability to supervise clinical practica in help relations
  - Experience in university teaching and student supervision
- Member of or eligible to the Ordre des psychologues du Québec.
- Proficiency in the French language\*
