Job description

The School of Psychoeducation is seeking applications for a full-time tenure-track assistant professor position at its Montreal and Laval campuses. Expertise in psychoeducational assessment, intervention with children or youth with adjustment difficulties, internalizing or developmental psychopathologies, or intervention with families or the elderly would be an invited focus.

Functions

The successful candidate will be expected to teach at undergraduate and graduate levels, supervise graduate students, pursue a solid research program, engage in publication and other outreach activities, and contribute to other activities of the institution.

Responsibilities

- » Ph.D. in psychoeducation or in a relevant discipline
- » Demonstrated ability to provide high quality university teaching
- » Research experience and an excellent record of publications in a relevant field
- » An adequate knowledge of the French written and spoken language **or** a strong commitment to mastering the proficiency level required, in accordance to [Université de Montréal's Language Policy](#). An institutional learning support program is offered to all professors wishing to learn French or improve their communication skills.

Assets

- » Clinical experience in psychoeducational assessment and intervention.
- » Postdoctoral training.
- » Member or eligibility to the *Ordre des psychoéducateurs et psychoéducatrices du Québec*.
- » Experience in the use of information and communication technologies in teaching.
- » Experience or interest in assessment or intervention using digital tools (e.g., digital health, telepractice).

How to submit your application

The application must be sent to the Director of the School of Psychoeducation by January 31, 2021, and must include the following:

- » A letter of motivation. In order to comply with the requirements of Government of Canada, please include in your cover letter one of the following statements: "I am a citizen/permanent resident of Canada" or "I am not a citizen/permanent resident of Canada" ;
 - » A curriculum vitae ;
 - » Two or three examples of recent publications or research work representative of the candidate's expertise ;
 - » A statement on teaching principles (maximum one page) ;
 - » A statement describing a proposed research program (no more than two pages) ;
- » Three letters of recommendation are also to be sent directly to the Director of the School of Psychoeducation by the referees.
